Dear colleagues, as the 8th EWICS is moving closer, below you may find the tentative schedule for the trip to Sinaia and Braşov.

During the trip transportation will be assured by bus, luggage insurance being included. Throughout the visit a guide will offer informations in English language.

The Peleş Castle, one of the most important Romanian historical buildings was built between 1873-1914 as summer residence for the first royal couple of Romania, King Carol I and Queen Elisabeta. It is considered to be the first building in Romania which has concrete foundations.



Hotel Palace Sinaia was built in 1911 during only 8 months and is another emblematic building of Sinaia. It is situated in the town center and characterized by the classical elegance of the 20th century.



Braşov is one of the biggest towns in Romania, situated in the central part of the country, near the Carpatian Mountains. Its architecture is influenced by the Saxon population which was highly present in the region until the end of the 20th century.
